# WAVEpact Guaranteed Admissions

- Continuous enrollment in VUSD grades 9-12
- Complete CSU A-G coursework with a C or better
- Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better
- Participate in CSUSM Early Assessment Program
- Take the SAT or ACT
- Complete the FAFSA during your senior year
- Submit a CSUSM application before November 30th of your senior year

## Preparing Students for College & Career Readiness



### What is CTE?

- CTE prepares all students to enter today's competitive workforce.
- Allows students to take industry-relevant classes connecting academics to real-world technical training with hands-on project based learning.
- State approved CTE industry courses, state of the art industry standard equipment, taught by industry professionals.
- Many CTE classes have community college credit articulation agreements with local community colleges.
- Many courses meet A-G requirements for the CSU and UC systems.

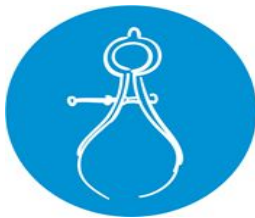

Remember: CTE courses are not just elective courses, they can and will lead to real jobs, real programs, and really good careers!

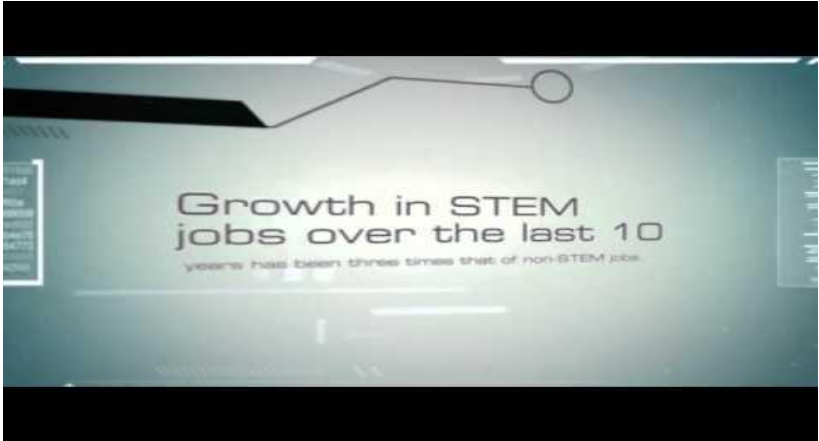
